DAILY BREAD – Advance Beginners and up.
Size - 13" W x 12" L x 4" H. \$65

This basket is woven of reed & dyed Hamburg cane and features an unusual shaped solid base. The base has crowfeet to finish it off. The sides alternate with Hamburg cane and reed and the rim is doubled lashed with Hamburg cane. The weaving is over/under and start/stop. It makes a perfect breadbasket. The instructor will bring several colors of dyed Hamburg cane for an accent color. Bring a **spoke weight**.

Usual basket tools including **spoke weight (a must!)** small & large clips, packers, needle nose pliers, angle cutters, scissors, scrapers, cutting board, measuring tape, electrical ties, spray bottle, and any other tools the student may find helpful.



CYBELLA – Intermediate and up– 6 hrs.
Intermediate. Size 6.5" across at bottom, 5.75" across at top x 7" H. \$60.

The basket is a mixture of round reed and flat oval in, natural, red and black. It has a base of 4-rod wale and extra spokes will be added as the base grows. The sides are over/under weavers mixed with 3-rod wale. Overlays provide extra color. The red rim is lashed with black waxed linen. Emphases will be on shaping to get a good "pot belly".

Usual basket tools including **A SPOKE WEIGHT**, small & large clips, packers, needle nose pliers, angle cutters, scissors, scrapers, cutting board, measuring tape, electrical ties, spray bottle, and any other tools the student may find helpful.

SPRING – Intermediate – 4-5 hrs. Size - : 9" W x 9" L (round) x 4.5" H. \$65

This basket begins on a 5" round oak base. Students will insert flat oval stakes into the slot following a template. The base will be secured with rows of 3-rod wale. Step-ups will be reviewed. Students will learn the beautiful diamond weave using turquoise and hyacinth colored reed. The basket is lashed with waxed linen. Students should be proficient at 3-rod wale.

Usual basket tools including small & large clips, packers, needle nose pliers, angle cutters, scissors, scrapers, cutting board, measuring tape, electrical ties, spray bottle, and any other tools the student may find helpful.



Amara – High Intermediate to Advanced – 4-5 hrs. - finished size 8.5" w x 6" h. - \$55

Beginning with a wooden slotted base, students will insert spokes and weave in several rows of 3 rod wale. Then using natural and a dyed strand of 3 mm FO, students will do the Japanese wave weave, creating the spirals in the basket. The basket is rimmed with half round and lashed with dyed 3 mm FO. Students must know 3-rod wale with a step-up. Choose from blue or deep red.

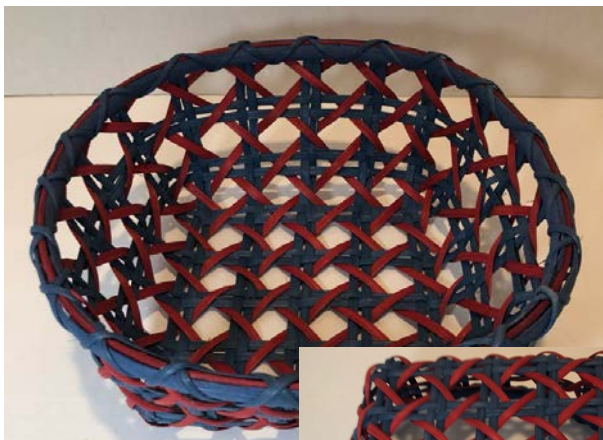
Needle nose pliers, angle cutters, large & smaller clips, packing tools, water & spray bottle and any other tools students find useful.



CHECKMATE – Advanced – 5-6 hrs. Size 11" x 11" across x 4.5" H. \$65

Learn the challenging chair cane pattern done in 3-D and make a lovely fruit bowl too! The basket begins by laying out the base flat on the table in a vertical and horizontal weave with royal blue spokes. The red diagonal weavers are added before upsetting the sides. On the sides will first weave in the double parallel row and then add the diagonals to lock the spokes in place. This basket is sure to stretch your weaving skills.

Usual basket tools including 2 spoke weights, small & large clips, packers, needle nose pliers, angle cutters, scissors, scrapers, cutting board, measuring tape, electrical ties, spray bottle, and any other tools the student may find helpful.

HOLIDAY ORNAMENT - Intermediate. 4-5 hrs. Size 3" roundish. \$50

This pretty ornament is a good introduction to waxed linen weaving. It is woven in 7-ply waxed linen, and features accents of twined wire and beads. It makes a lovely holiday ornament or suncatcher. Students will make one ornament, with choice of design.

Instructor will bring bobbins and needles for students to use in class. Students **MUST BE PROFICIENT AT TWINING**. Slow twiners will not finish this in class. Small packers, needle nose pliers, angle cutters, awl, & scissors.



PUMPKIN SPICE – Low Intermediate and up – 4 hrs. Size - 8" W x 8" L (square) x 4.25" H. \$55

This basket begins on a 5" square oak base. Students will insert flat oval stakes into the slot following a template. The base will be secured with rows of 3-rod wale. Step-ups will be reviewed. The sides are woven in a twill pattern in space dyed reed of gold, orange and brown. Each row is topped with dark green twining. The basket is lashed with waxed linen. Students should be proficient at 3-rod wale.

Usual basket tools including small & large clips, packers, needle nose pliers, angle cutters, scissors, scrapers, cutting board, measuring tape, electrical ties, spray bottle, and any other tools the student may find helpful.
